



audition sides & **INSTRUCTIONS**

First off, thank you so much for your submission!

During our shows, our actors perform and personify all sorts of things from children to fairies to gum stuck on the bottom of a shoe. Performers are often required to use their imaginations to create characters on-the-spot when a student has written only a one-word description. As such, our audition sides are a jumping-off-point, not scripted dialogue to memorize.

INSTRUCTIONS

Use the character guidelines below to create a single video of you performing your take on both of the characters, one after the other. Use the descriptions given to **create your own short monologues** for the characters you're imagining. We're looking for distinct vocal choices, strong physical characterizations (waist and above), and for your dialogue to fit your characterization choices. **More than anything, we want to see you play and have fun!**

CHARACTER GUIDELINE 1 - LION

DESCRIPTION: A royal, regal lion. Proud & pompous.

REQUIRED: A lion roar at some point

DIALOGUE IDEAS (NOT REQUIRED): Addressing a lion pride, writing a yelp review, taunting your prey

CHARACTER GUIDELINE 2 - BUNNY

DESCRIPTION: A small, cutesy bunny. Smart; uses their cuteness to their advantage.

REQUIRED: A moment of consecutive hops to emphasize a point

DIALOGUE IDEAS (NOT REQUIRED): Complaining to a parent about not getting enough video game time, a heist-like briefing on the new plan to steal from the farmer's garden, a breakdown on why carrot cake is the greatest dessert in existence

**Try not to overthink these; short and sweet is encouraged.
All video submissions must be under 3 minutes in total length.**
